

## Faculty Position Chemical Engineering

The Department of Chemical Engineering at Michigan Technological University (MTU) invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant or Associate Professor level for Fall 2012. All research areas of chemical engineering will be considered. Applicants must have a PhD in Chemical Engineering or a closely related discipline. A single PDF file containing a letter of application, a curriculum vitae, statements of research plans and teaching interests, and the names and contact information of four professional references should be submitted electronically to Prof. Ching-An Peng, Faculty Search Committee Chair at <a href="mailto:cmsearch@mtu.edu">cmsearch@mtu.edu</a>. Review of applications will begin on November 15, 2011, and continue until the position is filled.
